Our commitment to your student athlete extends off the training pitch and we work closely with ASU's Learning Success Coaches assigned to our players to make sure they are academically successful. Especially designed so that our players abroad can flourish in their European time zone and work around their soccer training and competitive schedules, ASU offers guidance and teacher support LIVE on the phone, as well as DIGITALLY in email, text and Zooms.

We receive weekly progress report updates on each student and know how they are performing in every class.

What are the teachers like?

Our highly qualified teachers are the driving force behind the learning experience at ASU Prep Digital. Each student is assigned a teacher for each course to provide live instructions via video chat and one-on-one feedback via email, text, phone, or video chat. Students enrolled in our university-level courses will also receive instructions from ASU professors.

In addition, all students are assigned a personal Learning Success Coach to help them stay on track and plan a path to college and careers.

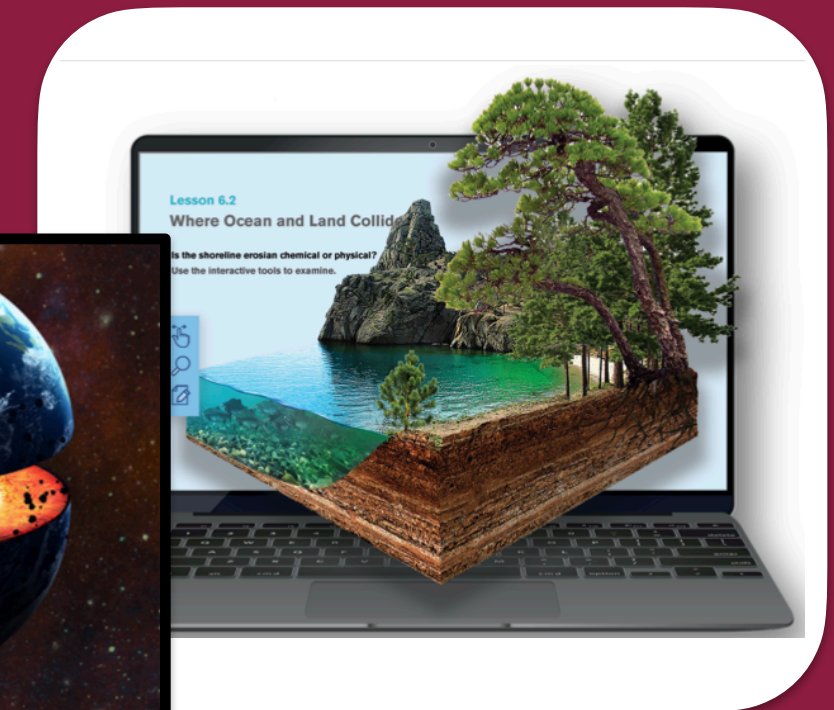
What are the courses like?

The ASU Prep Digital high school courses are built on a college prep framework. This rigorous curriculum prepares students to become global thinkers and leaders, equipping them for success beyond university.

Teachers conduct live lessons via video chat several times each week. These are interactive sessions that engage small groups of students in discussion and shared learning.

Students will also work through online lessons at their own pace thanks to learning technologies that adapt to meet individual needs. Throughout the course, they will read materials, watch videos, play games, write papers, participate in discussions, create projects and apply knowledge in virtual reality environments.

All the course materials are online, but students are asked to apply lessons to real-world situations, participate in lab sessions and collaborate with classmates and their community.

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Become part of Arizona State University

The best part of being an ASU Prep Digital student is having access to the resources of the university ranked #1 in innovation (ahead of MIT and Stanford by U.S. News and World Report for the last four years). Our high school students can take college courses, test drive college majors and potential careers, and even get a sense for ASU campus life through optional summer camps and internships.

High school students can earn college credit when they complete one of our 200+ online college courses. Many of these university-level courses can also be taken as concurrent credit, earning you both high school and college credit at the same time. This saves you time and money when you get to college. As ASU is a top-tier, research-led university, the college credit earned will transfer almost anywhere. This is not the case with all dual-enrollment programs.

Students can work with their **Learning Success Coach** to create a personalized college and career pathway. This aligns concurrent courses to university majors and gives students a head start. When they complete these courses in high school at much lower tuition rates, they arrive on campus with many credits already completed (and money in the bank). Two university courses are included in our full-time tuition.

When students successfully graduate from the ASU Prep Digital full-time program with at least a 3.0 GPA, they meet the requirements for admission to Arizona State University and the Arizona Board of Regents admissions requirements for the other state universities.



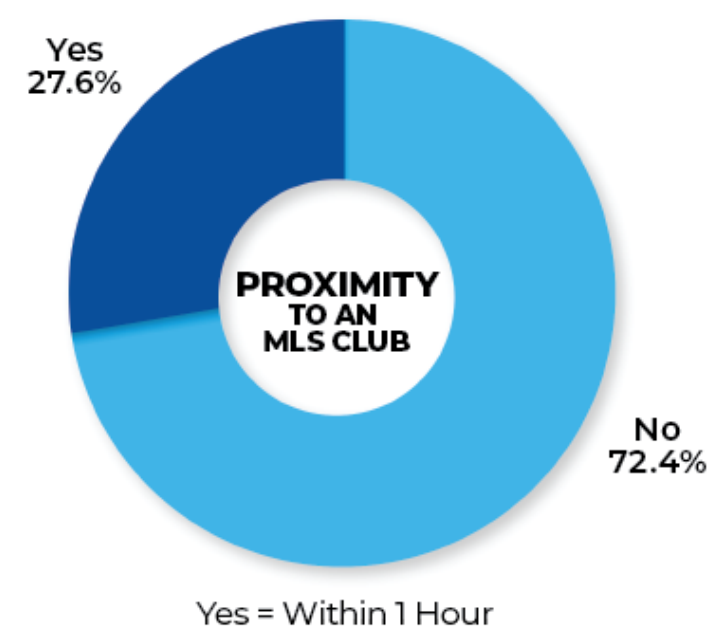
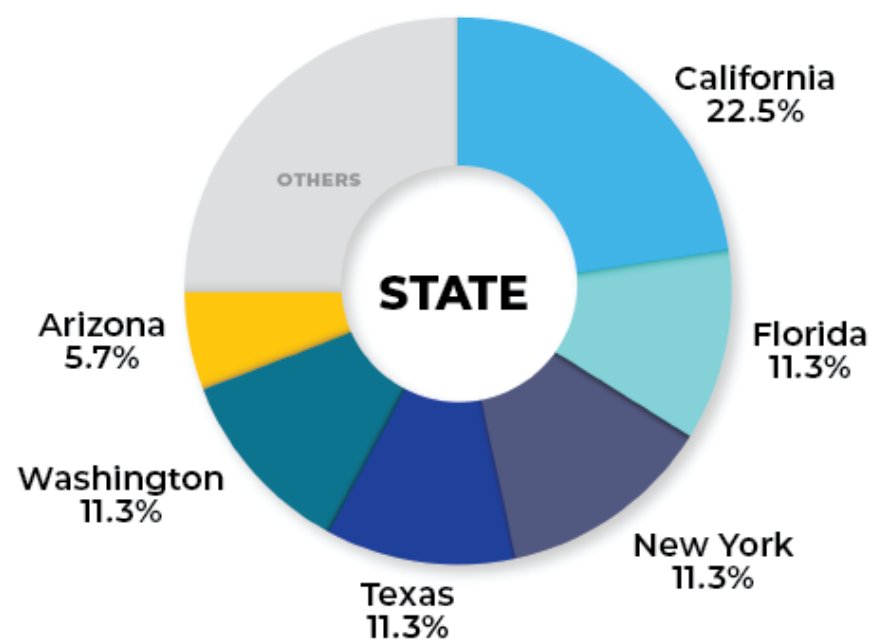
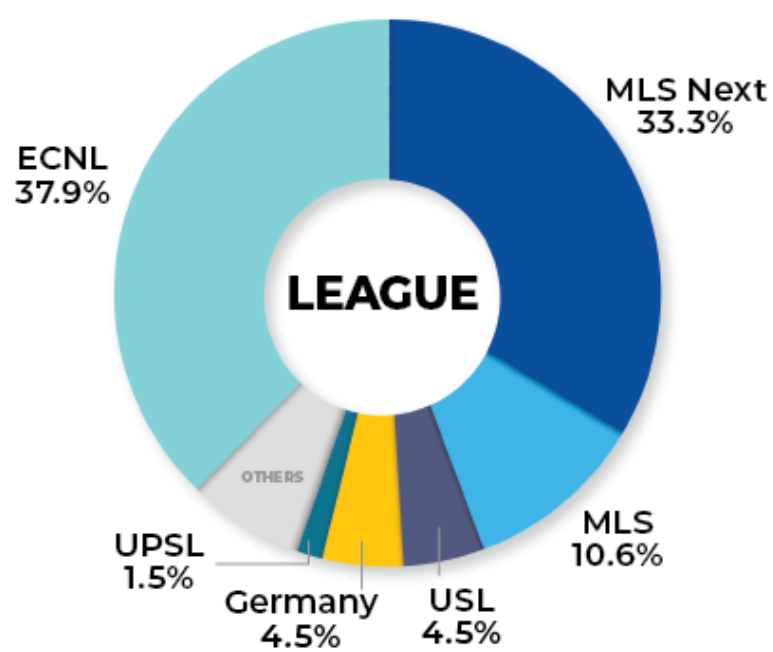

How much does it cost?

ASU Prep Digital offers tuition-based options for Out-of-State (non-AZ residents) and international students. Arizona residents can attend the ASU Prep Digital full-time program tuition-free.

For International Soccer Academy soccer player students, ASU Prep Digital provides a special tuition rate of \$575 per court enrollment.

When is enrollment?

What type of students attend ASU Prep Digital?



We have all types of students from all over the world, but they fall into two basic groups-part-time and full time

Part-time Students

Students that take courses as a supplement to their traditional school or homeschool studies are considered part-time. Many attend local high schools and use the ASU Prep Digital courses as a way to get ahead and begin their accelerated path to university majors.

Part-time students have the flexibility to work anywhere, on their own schedule, and at their own pace. Some work in classrooms as part of their school's partnership with ASU Prep Digital. Others work on their own at home after school.

Full-time Students

Students taking four or more courses are considered full-time.

ASU Prep Digital is an accredited Arizona school and we award high school diplomas to qualifying seniors. Full-time students have the flexibility to work anywhere, on their own schedule, and at their own pace. They also have the opportunity to accelerate their path to college and careers by taking concurrent university courses that earn them both high school and college credits.

This is not a credit recovery or GED program

While ASU believes all students can be successful and is committed to surrounding them with the support needed to achieve their goals, this is a rigorous college-prep program. It is not designed for students who need to make up credits quickly or those seeking a GED.

Students are not eligible to enroll after their 21st birthday.
